Summary: Creative Girls Rock was founded October 17, 2017, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that was birthed

from my passion for creative arts, youth development, community engagement; and a therapeutic method for anxiety Creative Girls Rock mission is to educate, empower young girls and women to use their creative talents to enhance their world and the world around them. Creative Girls Rock, serves low to moderate low-income families locally and globally.

Here's a few CGR objectives:

- Build a self-awareness and confidence in one's creative talents
- Create safe and fun spaces for community interaction for all ages, cultures, and income levels
- Provide an atmosphere of inter-generational networking and
- Promote Do It Yourself (DIY) Projects.

Creative Girls Rock initiative is to design creative art, strengthen mental health and wellness living, build women empowerment and provide strong youth development. Within the past year the Creative Girls Rock have completed (7) mural projects with over 160 participants, the murals are located at: Slim and Husky's Nashville, Tennessee State University, Nashville Public Library: Bordeaux, Downtown and Madison branches, Cheekwood Botanical Garden and Napier Elementary School.
