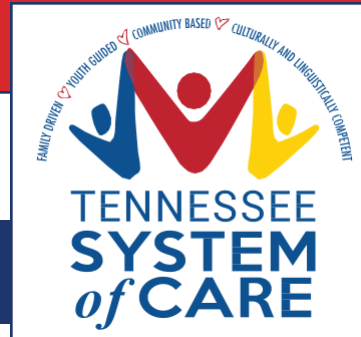

INITIAL ASSESSMENT: Yes

WAIT TIME: Same Day/ Next Day

OUTCOME: Determines mental health and substance abuse diagnosis, social history, treatment recommendations.

SERVICES OFFERED: Therapy/Counseling, Psychiatric Evaluation and Treatment, Intensive In-Home Treatment, Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), School-Based Therapy, Substance Abuse Treatment, Therapeutic Foster Care, Early Childhood Services, Tennessee Health Link Care Coordination, SSVF (Supportive Services for Veteran Families- case management and housing assistance to low income Veteran families who are homeless or within 2 weeks of becoming homeless), Criminal Justice Liaison (TDMHSAS grant provides liaison and case management services to inmates with mental health issues who are being released back to their communities), Therapeutic Intervention, Education, and Skills (TIES)

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy; Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy; Eye Movement Desensitization & Reprocessing; Seeking Safety; Motivational Interviewing; Solution-Focused Therapy; Dialectical Behavioral Therapy; Play Therapy; Contingency Management (substance use treatment); Circle of Courage (a positive youth development model); Reality Therapy; Gestalt Therapy; Making a Difference (teen pregnancy and HIV/STD prevention); Be Proud! Be Responsible! (youth empowerment & HIV reduction); Sexual Health and Adolescent Risk Prevention; Second Step (violence & bullying prevention); First Step to Success (early intervention for children at risk for aggressive or antisocial behavior patterns); Growing Great Kids (prenatal to 36 months); Moving Beyond Depression (in-home maternal depression model); Circle of Security (parenting); Thera play; CHOICES; 24/7 Dad (fatherhood curriculum); Inside-Out Dad (for incarcerated fathers)

WAIT TIME: Same day assessment and walk-in availability

OUTCOME: Diagnosis, Social History, Treatment Recommendations

SERVICES OFFERED: Tennessee Health Link Coordination, Medication Management, Therapy, Continuous Treatment Team, Child and Youth Continuous Treatment Team, Comprehensive Child and Family Treatment, System of Care Across Tennessee

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Zero Suicide Initiative, Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training, Assessing and Managing Suicide Risk, Columbia-Suicide Severity Rating Scale, Motivational Interviewing, Transtheoretical Model (Stages of Change), Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing, Wraparound

OUTCOME: Social History, Treatment History, Treatment Recommendations, Family Counseling

SERVICES OFFERED: Intensive In-home Services, Case Management Services, Thrive (Juvenile Justice Grant Funded Program)

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Collaborative Problem Solving (CPS), Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy (TFCB-T), Adolescent Community Reinforcement Approach (ACRA), Motivational Interviewing (MI)

INITIAL ASSESSMENT: Yes

WAIT TIME: 24 hours for initial contact, 3 days to assessment based on family availability

OUTCOME: In home services based on needs identified on assessment. Therapy or medication management in the office setting. Recommendations based on assessment. In home services based on needs identified on assessment. Address mental health, substance use, family conflict, and social determinants of health needs.

SERVICES OFFERED: Outpatient Treatment, Medication management, Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Tennessee Health Link Care Coordination, Addictions assessments, mental health intake and recommendations. A&D assessments, A&D outpatient therapy

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: ACRA, Nurturing parenting, TF-CBT

OUTCOME: Parent/Caregiver Peer Support, Resource Linkage, Safety Planning, and Treatment Recommendations

SERVICES OFFERED: Family Support Services, Psychiatric Medication Management, Telehealth Therapy, Referral, Advocacy, Outreach, and Training

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Strengthening Families, Youth Screen, Statewide Family Support Network, Child Care Consultation, CBT, TF-CBT

WAIT TIME: No wait time; contact attempted within 24 hours.

OUTCOME: Biopsychosocial assessment, diagnosis, treatment recommendations, therapeutic and case management services

SERVICES OFFERED: Intensive Outpatient Co-Occurring Substance Abuse and Mental Health Group for adults and adolescents, Comprehensive Child and Family Treatment (CCFT), Outpatient Therapy, Medication Management, Health Link, Supervised Visitation

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Rational Emotive Therapy (RET), Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT), Homebuilders Model, Motivational Interviewing, Trust-Based Relational Intervention
