**WAIT TIME:** Same Day/ Next Day; Serviced out of neighboring county clinics

**OUTCOME:** Determines mental health and substance abuse diagnosis, social history, treatment recommendations

**SERVICES OFFERED:** School-Based Therapy, Intensive In-Home Treatment, Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Co-Occurring Disorders Treatment, Tennessee Health Link Care Coordination, SSVF (Supportive Services for Veteran Families- case management and housing assistance to low income Veteran families who are homeless or within 2 weeks of becoming homeless)

**EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE:** Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT); Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT); Play Therapy; Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR); Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT); Solution-Focused Therapy (SFBT); Motivational Interviewing (MI); Seeking Safety; Hazelden Co-Occurring Disorders Program; Integrated Dual Diagnosis Treatment (IDDT); Motivational Enhancement Therapy (MET); The Matrix Model (intensive alcohol & drug treatment for teens and young adults); Art Therapy; Circle of Courage (a positive youth development model); Making a Difference (teen pregnancy and HIV/STD prevention); Be Proud! Be Responsible! (youth empowerment & HIV reduction); Sexual Health and Adolescent Risk Prevention (SHARP); Keepin' it REAL (middle school substance use prevention)
