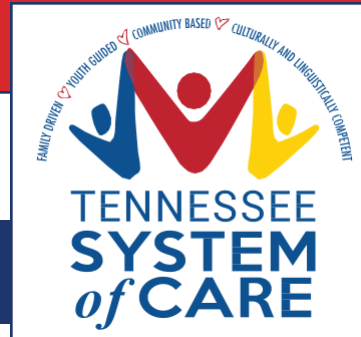

INITIAL ASSESSMENT: Yes

WAIT TIME: Same Day/ Next Day

OUTCOME: Determines mental health and substance abuse diagnosis, social history, treatment recommendations

SERVICES OFFERED: Intensive in-Home Treatment, Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Therapeutic Foster Care, Tennessee Health Link Care Coordination, SSVF (Supportive Services for Veteran Families- case management and housing assistance to low income Veteran families who are homeless or within 2 weeks of becoming homeless), Criminal Justice Liaison (TDMHSAS grant provides liaison and case management services to inmates with mental health issues who are being released back to their communities), Early Childhood Services.

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT); Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT); Motivational Interviewing (MI); Solution-Focused Therapy (SFBT); Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT); Reality Therapy; Play Therapy; Contingency Management (substance use treatment); Circle of Courage (a positive youth development model); Making a Difference (teen pregnancy and HIV/STD prevention); Be Proud! Be Responsible! (youth empowerment & HIV reduction); Sexual Health and Adolescent Risk Prevention (SHARP); Peace Works (social skill enhancement); Pyramid Model (social emotional competence in young children)

OUTCOME: Social history, treatment history, treatment recommendations, family counseling

SERVICES OFFERED: Intensive in-home services, case management services, Thrive (Juvenile Justice Grant Funded Program)

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Collaborative Problem Solving (CPS), Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy (TFCB-T), Adolescent Community Reinforcement Approach (ACRA), Motivational Interviewing (MI)

WAIT TIME: Same day assessment and walk-in availability

OUTCOME: Diagnosis, Social History, Treatment Recommendations

SERVICES OFFERED: TN Health Link Care Coordination, Medication Management, Therapy, Continuous Treatment Team (CTT), Child and Youth Continuous Treatment Team (C&Y CTT), Comprehensive Child and Family Treatment (CCFT)

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Zero Suicide Initiative (ZSI), Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST), Assessing and Managing Suicide Risk (AMSR), Columbia-Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS), Motivational Interviewing (MI), Trans theoretical Model (Stages of Change), Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Trauma-Focused CBT (TF-CBT), Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT), Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR)

WAIT TIME: 24 hours for initial contact, 3 days to assessment based on family availability

OUTCOME: In-home services based on needs identified on assessment. Therapy or medication management in the office setting. Address mental health, substance use, family conflict, and social determinants of health needs.

SERVICES OFFERED: Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Tennessee Health Link (THL) Care Coordination, Substance Abuse Assessment, Mental Health Assessment, Individual, Family, and Couples Outpatient Therapy, Alcohol and Drug Outpatient Therapy, Medication Management. Telehealth options are available for all services.

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Nurturing Parenting, Living in Balance, TFCBT, DBT, CBT, PCIT, Play Therapy, Prime for Life, SVN
