

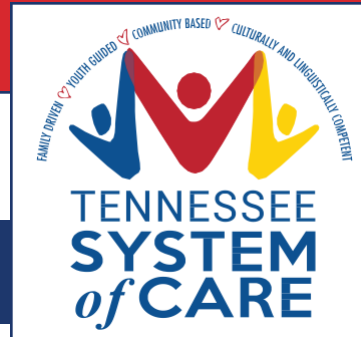

OUTCOME: Determines mental health and substance abuse diagnosis, social history, treatment recommendations

SERVICES OFFERED: Mental Health Outpatient Services including Psychiatric evaluation, therapy, medication management, co-occurring programming, Adult Addictions Intensive Outpatient, Continuous Treatment Team (CTT), Comprehensive Child and Family Treatment (Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Tennessee Health Link Care Coordination

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT); Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT); Eye Movement Desensitization & Reprocessing (EMDR); Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT); ARC, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT), Child Parent Psychotherapy (CPP); Hazelton's Co-occurring, System of Care Across Tennessee (SOCAT)

WAIT TIME: 24 hours for initial contact, 3 days to assessment based on family availability.

OUTCOME: In-home services based on needs identified on assessment. Therapy or medication management in the office setting. Recommendations based on assessment.

SERVICES OFFERED: Comprehensive Child and Family Therapy (CCFT), Tennessee Health Link (THL) Care Coordination, Substance Abuse Assessment, Mental Health Assessment, Individual, Family, and Couples Outpatient Therapy, Alcohol and Drug Outpatient Therapy, Medication Management. Telehealth options are available for all services.

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES AVAILABLE: ACRA, Nurturing parenting, TF-CBT, CPP, CBT, Motivational Interviewing.
