

The committee has identified this emerging issue for providers, healthcare facilities and organizations from the third quarter of Maternal Mortality Reviews

- The State should provide funding for the establishment/expansion of dyad residential treatment facilities for moms with newborns and substance use disorder that will accept Medicaid.
- State and federal agencies should increase funding to support the awareness and benefit of Certified Peer Recovery Services in the childbearing population.
- Facilities should provide training to all providers at the time of hire and annually on continuity of care for pregnant and postpartum women with substance use disorder.
- Providers should educate and provide resources on continuity of care for pregnant and postpartum women with substance use disorder at each point of contact
- Providers who treat women of childbearing age with complex medical histories should be counseled on contraception options and options should pregnancy occur.
- Obstetric providers who treat women of childbearing age with complex medical histories should refer for appropriate consultation and follow-up in early pregnancy.
