**RE: Religious Declination of Newborn Eye Treatment**

Public Chapter 989 will go into effect July 1, 2016. This amends TCA 68-5-502 to allow for a religious exemption to newborn eye treatment as long as there is a written statement filed with the Tennessee Department of Health. Should families have a religious objection to the prophylactic treatment of a newborn's eyes, hospitals should document that declination according to protocols established by the facility. This should include a statement of religious objection and parental signature. The hospital's religious declination form should be sent to the Tennessee Department of Health via secure email to NBS.health@tn.gov or secure fax (615)532-8555. These will then be kept on file by the Tennessee Department of Health, Division of Family Health and Wellness Newborn Screening Section. Questions may be directed to Margaret Major.
