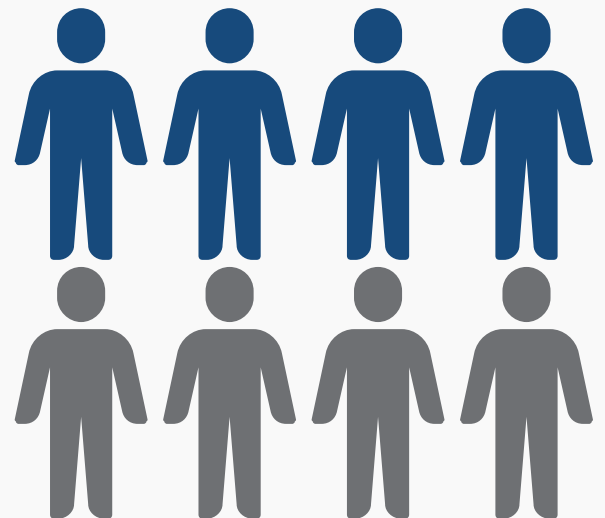


76% of clients who received Part B food assistance **are virally suppressed**
