Please be advised that in considering the state of emergency issued by Governor Lee and subsequent related directives, which institute measures aimed at stopping and containing the spread of the coronavirus COVID-19 within the state, the staff of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission are working remotely until advised that working conditions have returned to normal and directed to return to the office.

As such, until further notice, all docket filings must be made electronically by email to tpuc.docketroom@tn.gov. Consistent with TPUC rules for filings made electronically, all filings shall be followed by an original and 4 additional printed copies. The electronic filing date will be honored as the official date (if the filing is complete and contains all components that are required to be filed). Please file one .pdf with all components of a filing organized in the desired order of arrangement. Documents made by U.S. mail or any method other than electronically, as noted above, will not be processed until normal office working conditions resume and may be considered untimely, as determined by applicable deadlines, including those established by statute, hearing officer, or the presiding Commissioner or Chair of the Commission.
