2021 INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY 6 PM FRIDAY, JULY 2, 2021 – 5:59 AM TUESDAY, JULY 6, 2021 84-HOUR HOLIDAY PERIOD

- **FATAL CRASHES: 8**

Three crashes were single-vehicle crashes, and five (5) were multiple-vehicle crashes.

- **FATALITIES: 8**

3 (37.5%) of the fatalities were alcohol-related.

6 (75%) of the people killed were motor vehicle occupants.

- Of the 6 occupant fatalities, **4** (66.7%) were not wearing a safety restraint.
- **No** child passengers requiring a child restraint device were killed.
- **Two** motorcyclists were killed; one of the two was wearing a helmet properly.
- **No** pedalcyclists were killed.
- **No** pedestrians were killed.
