Three crashes were single-vehicle crashes, and five (5) were multiple-vehicle crashes.

• FATALITIES: 8

3 (37.5%) of the fatalities were alcohol-related.

6 (75%) of the people killed were motor vehicle occupants.

- ➤ Of the 6 occupant fatalities, **4** (66.7%) were not wearing a safety restraint.
- ➤ No child passengers requiring a child restraint device were killed.
- > Two motorcyclists were killed; one of the two was wearing a helmet properly.
- ➤ No pedalcyclists were killed.
- ➤ No pedestrians were killed.
