FINAL HOLIDAY REPORT MARCH 15, 2018

2017 ST. PATRICK'S DAY HOLIDAY FRIDAY, MARCH 17 – SUNDAY, MARCH 19 72-HOUR HOLIDAY PERIOD

- **FATAL CRASHES: 7**

Five crashes were single vehicle crashes, and two were multiple vehicle crashes.

- **FATALITIES: 7**

Four (57%) of the fatalities were alcohol-related.

Seven (100%) of the people killed were motor vehicle occupants.

- Of the seven occupant fatalities, two (57%) were not wearing a safety restraint.
- No child passengers requiring a child restraint device were killed.
- No motorcyclists were killed.
- No pedalcyclists were killed.
- No pedestrians were killed.
