
Pre-K and Kindergarten Enrollment, Rule

The Background:

This rule change requires non-public schools to comply with the requirements of Public Chapter 85 (2013) and Public Chapter 991 (2012) that stipulate the cut-off age for students to enroll in kindergarten and pre-kindergarten.

The Recommendation:

SBE staff recommend acceptance of this item on first reading.

Proposed Rule Revision

0520-07-02-.02(1) is amended by adding subparagraph (1)(d) which shall state:

“Each school shall comply with the requirements of T.C.A. §§ 49-6-104(a) and 49-6-201(b)(3) regarding the age requirements for students entering kindergarten and pre-kindergarten.”

0520-07-02-.03(9)(v) is amended by adding part (v)(XI) which shall state:

“Each school shall comply with the requirements of T.C.A. §§ 49-6-104(a) and 49-6-201(b)(3) regarding the age requirements for students entering kindergarten and pre-kindergarten.”

0520-07-02-.05(2) is amended by adding subparagraph (2)(f) which shall state:

“Each school shall comply with the requirements of T.C.A. §§ 49-6-104(a) and 49-6-201(b)(3) regarding the age requirements for students entering kindergarten and pre-kindergarten.”

0520-07-02-.06 is amended by adding paragraph (12) which shall state:

“Each school shall comply with the requirements of T.C.A. §§ 49-6-104(a) and 49-6-201(b)(3) regarding the age requirements for students entering kindergarten and pre-kindergarten.”
