
Approved High School Courses Policy 3.205

The Background:

T.C.A. § 49-1-302(a)(8) authorizes the State Board of Education to “set policies governing all curricula and courses of study in the public schools.” Additionally, State Board rule 0520-01-03-.05(1) calls for the State Board of Education to adopt standards for each subject area, grades K-12. The approved standards are to be the basis for planning instructional programs in each local school system.

This item proposes to add the following courses to the list of approved high school courses.

These courses will be available for the 2018-19 school year.

Proposed new courses:

Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security
Criminal Justice IV: Practicum
Pre-Law I
Pre-Law II
Pre-Law III

Marketing
Foundations of Supply Chain Management
Supply Chain Management I
Supply Chain Management II
Supply Chain Management Practicum

Since first reading, Tennessee Student Success has also been added as a General Education Exploratory course.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department of Education prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule, or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:
