
Coordinated School Health Program Policy 4.204

The Background:

Policy 4.204, formerly titled *Standards and Guidelines for Tennessee's Coordinated School Health Program*, was originally passed by the State Board of Education in 2000 for use in the Coordinated School Health (CSH) pilot program. Since that time the CSH program has expanded to all districts and is no longer in pilot status. On first read, changes to the policy were presented to update statutory references and requirements and to reflect the changes in national best practices for CSH. This item was identified for updating through the rule and policy audit being conducted by the State Board and the Department of Education.

There have been minimal edits and technical revisions since first reading.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule, or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends adoption of this item on final reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
