
Approved High School Courses Policy 3.205

The Background:

T.C.A. § 49-1-302(a)(8) authorizes the State Board of Education to “set policies governing all curricula and courses of study in the public schools.” Additionally, State Board Rule 0520-01-03-.05(1) calls for the State Board of Education to adopt standards for each subject area, grades K-12. The approved standards are to be the basis for planning instructional programs in each local school system.

This item proposes to add the following courses to the list of approved high school courses.

These courses will be available for the 2018-19 school year.

Proposed new courses:

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| Mathematics |
| Statewide Dual Credit Pre-Calculus |
| Statewide Dual Credit Statistics |

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| Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security |
| Statewide Dual Credit Criminal Justice |

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:
