
Charter School Revocation Policy 6.110

The Background:

The Charter School Revocation policy outlines the process and criteria the State Board will use when considering an appeal of an LEA's decision to revoke a charter agreement and when considering the revocation of a charter agreement where the State Board serves as the chartering authority.

A review of all the State Board's charter school authorizer policies was conducted to ensure alignment with updates to the High Quality Charter Schools Act and the development of the Tennessee state charter school authorizing standards. Additionally, now that the State Board has authorized charter schools in operation, updates were needed to better reflect current practices.

There has been one change since first reading:

- Page 1 – To provide additional information around the timeline for the submission of a notice of appeal to the State Board in an appeal of a revocation decision by an LEA.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends adoption of this item on final reading.
