## Anita Himes Revocation

## The Background:

- Facts:On February 13, 2018, Respondent resigned from Lawrence County Schools, in lieu of<br/>termination. Respondent showed incompetence on special education paperwork in<br/>regards to IEPs. Respondent did not meet within the year to complete annual IEPs for<br/>students. Respondent did not complete triennial evaluations according to timelines.<br/>Respondent failed to provide parents/guardians/students with ten day notices to<br/>meetings. Respondent did not include all components of instructionally appropriate IEPs<br/>even after several trainings and one-on-one assistance to address issues. Respondent did<br/>not include appropriate team members at IEP meetings. Respondent dismissed students<br/>from special education without proper documentation and data.
- Status: Respondent was notified via certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her license based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice, but did not request a hearing.

## The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Emergency Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3)(g), (h), (4)(c)(8).

The Board staff recommends that Respondent's Tennessee educator license be revoked.
