Ondre Johnson Revocation

The Background:

- Facts:On January 19, 2018, Respondent pled guilty to 2 counts of aggravated assault and 1 count
of criminal attempt of second degree murder (all felonies) and was sentenced to TDOC
for 10 years for criminal attempt of second degree murder and to the workhouse for 3
years for each aggravated assault charge. Respondent charged on March 23, 2017.
Incident that lead to charge and conviction happened on December 6, 2016.
- Status: Respondent was notified via certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice, but did not request a hearing.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(a).

The Board staff recommends that Respondent's Tennessee educator license be revoked.
