Revocation**

The Background:

Facts: Respondent was suspended for 10 days in January 2017 in the state of Georgia for using inappropriate language and/or profanity towards students. Specifically, two students complained that he called one a faggot/sissy and the other one a “bitch ass nigger.”

Status: Respondent was notified via certified mail of the Board’s intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice, but did not request a hearing.

The Recommendation:

Respondent’s conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(e).

The Board staff recommends that Respondent’s Tennessee educator license be revoked.
