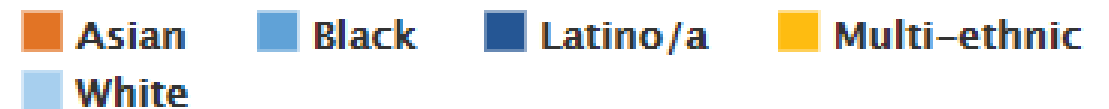
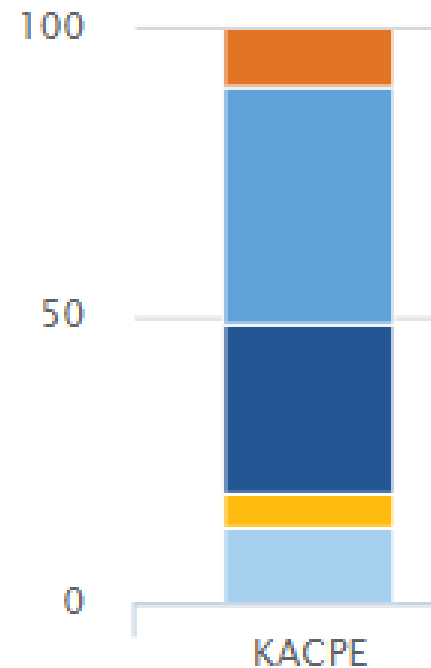
# KACPE is racially and economically diverse

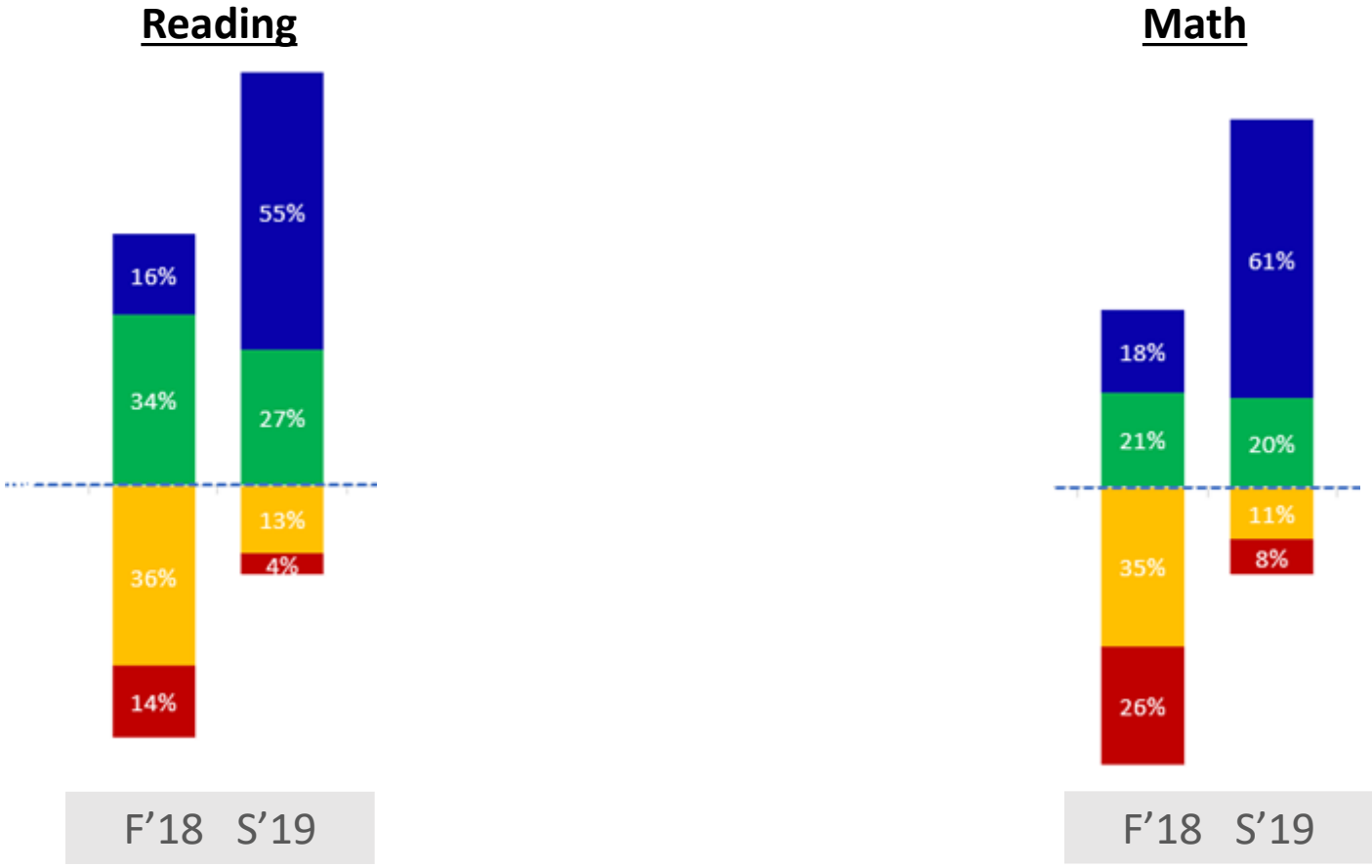

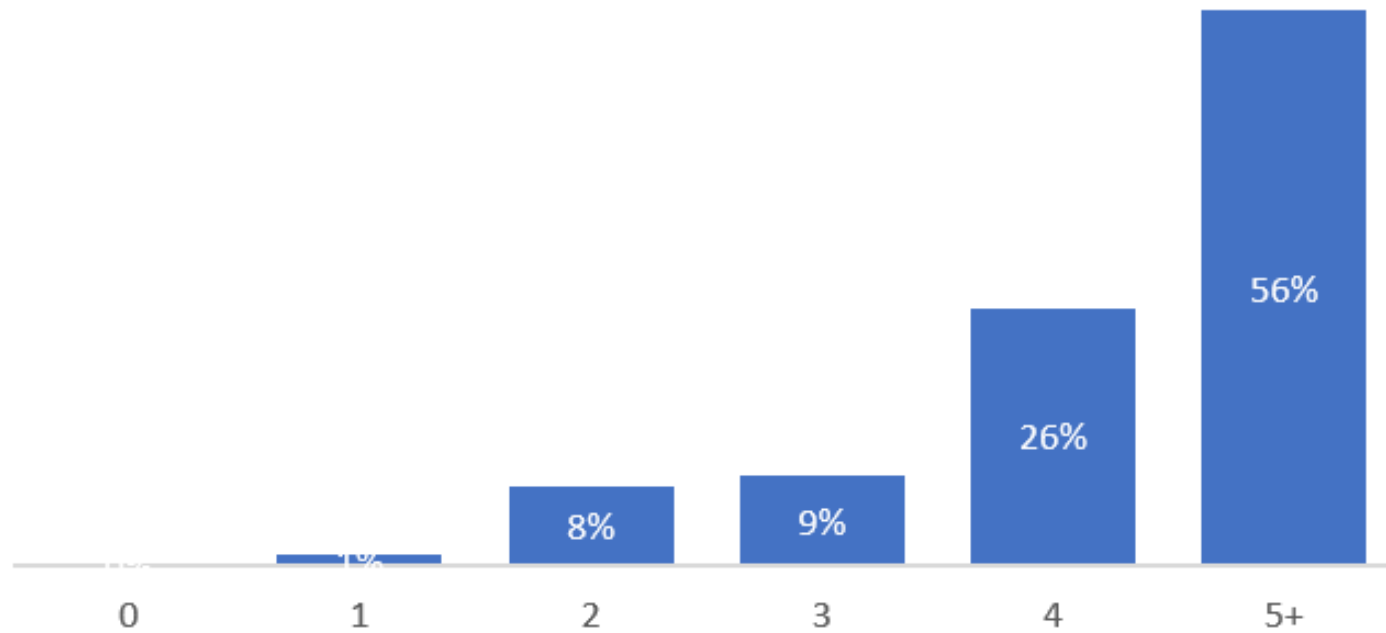

# We will continue to set the bar high

## Enrollment

- 295 students (Kinder: 150; First: 145)

## Attendance

- $\geq 95\%$

## Chronic Absenteeism

- $\leq 3\%$

## Student Attrition

- $\leq 5\%$  (in-year) and  $\leq 16\%$  from Oct 1, 2019 through Oct 1, 2020

## MAP

- Kinder: by EOY,  $\geq 20\%$  reach top quartile;  $\leq 20\%$  remain in bottom quartile
- First: by EOY,  $\geq 40\%$  reach top quartile;  $\geq 80\%$  reach top two quartiles
