Jaime Byram Revocation –Automatic

The Background:

Facts:

On March 4, 2019, Ms. Byram pleaded guilty to and was given judicial diversion for the following drug offenses: Facilitation of Possession of a Schedule I Controlled Substance (LSD) with the Intent to Deliver, a class C felony; Facilitation of Possession of a Schedule I Controlled Substance (Ecstasy) with the Intent to Deliver, a class C felony; Possession of a Schedule VI Controlled Substance (Marijuana) with the Intent to Deliver (over ½ an ounce), a class E felony; Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a class A misdemeanor; and Maintaining a Dwelling for the Purpose of Drug Use, a class D felony. Ms. Byram's diversion runs concurrent for all charges; she is on supervised probation until March 18, 2023

Status:

Respondent and her attorney were notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke Respondent's educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for automatic license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a).

The Board staff recommends the automatic revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license.
