

**Monrita Tate
Restoration**

The Background:

Facts: In 2017, Ms. Tate's license was revoked due to two pending criminal charges of assault, alleging that she pulled a student by the hair. Ms. Tate's license was revoked prior to the resolution of her criminal case. Ultimately, one of the assault charges was dismissed without prosecution. Ms. Tate was found not guilty by a jury of the second count of assault. Ms. Tate's license has been revoked for over two years.

Status: Respondent was notified by electronic mail and by phone on October 30, 2019, of the Board staff's recommendation to grant restoration of her license at the Board's next regularly scheduled meeting.

The Recommendation:

Pursuant to Board Policy 5.500, the Board staff recommends that Educator's license be restored based upon the policy considerations deemed relevant by the Board to show that an educator has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant license restoration.
