

Repeal Charter School Authorizing Mission Policy 6.100

The Background:

State Board Policy 6.100 establishes the State Board's mission with regard to its role as an appellate authorizer of charter schools and as an authorizer of charter schools where an LEA is the sponsor. In April 2019, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 219 which created the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (Commission) and transferred the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission effective July 1, 2021.

The Commission has approved policies which govern its work as a charter school authorizer and LEA. In order to complete the transition of the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission in compliance with Public Chapter 219, this item proposes a repeal of State Board Policy 6.100 which establishes its authorizing mission.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends approval of this item on final reading.
