

Repeal Charter School Intervention Policy 6.700

The Background:

State Board Policy 6.700 sets forth the criteria and process for charter school intervention decisions and actions by the State Board with regard to its authorized charter schools. In April 2019, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 219 creating the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (Commission) and transferred the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission effective July 1, 2021.

The Commission has approved rules and policies to govern its work as a charter school authorizer and LEA. In order to complete the transition of the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission in compliance with Public Chapter 219, this item proposes a repeal of State Board Policy 6.700.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
