
Repeal Charter School Amendment and Appeals Rule 0520-14-01-.06

The Background:

State Board Rule 0520-14-01-.06 governs the timeline and process for a charter school to amend a charter agreement and appeal an amendment petition denial by a local board of education to the State Board of Education pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-13-110. In May 2021, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 493 which transferred charter school amendment timeline and appeal process authority from the State Board of Education to the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission.

The Commission has approved emergency rules to govern the amendment timeline and appeal process. In order to complete the transition of amendment authority to the Commission, this item proposes a repeal of section .06 of the State Board rule that governs the amendment and appeal processes.

There have not been any changes since first reading.

The Recommendation:

The SBE staff recommends approval of this item on final reading.
