Automatic Licensure Actions Revocation and Permanent Revocation

The Background:

Pursuant to T.C.A. §§ 49-5-413, 49-5-417, and State Board of Education Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a), the State Board of Education is required to automatically revoke or automatically permanently revoke the license of an educator for certain criminal offenses and classifications set forth in law. All cases are reviewed and acted upon according to the rule that was in place when the conviction or qualifying event occurred.

The Recommendation:

State law and State Board rules require the Board to take action, and State Board staff recommends approval of the recommended actions outlined in the attached document.
