Equity for Every Student A Simple Solution:

A Floor in the Components


Current Formula

BEP Component	Average Formula Shares	Floor
Instructional Salaries	70% State 30% Local	None
Instructional Benefits	70% State 30% Local	None
Classroom	75% State 25% Local	None
Non-Classroom	50% State 50% Local	25% State 75% Local

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Proposed Formula Change

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Instructional Salaries	70% State 30% Local	50% State 50% Local
Instructional Benefits	70% State 30% Local	50% State 50% Local
Classroom	75% State 25% Local	50% State 50% Local
Non-Classroom	50% State 50% Local	25% State 75% Local



Other Districts Who May Be Impacted in the Future Are:

- Williamson County Classroom Component currently 51.25%
- Franklin Special Classroom Component currently 51.25%
- Davidson County Classroom Component currently 53.02 %

What this change accomplishes:

- Safety Mechanism for every System
- Guarantees more Equitable Share of State Funding for <u>Every</u> Student
- No impact on any other LEAs
