
Administration of Medication for Adrenal Insufficiency, Rule 0520-01-13

The Background:

On March 23, 2017, Governor Haslam signed Public Chapter 84 that requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules allowing for the administration of medication that treats adrenal insufficiency for students while at school. This first read item proposes rules for LEAs to follow in the administration of medication that treats adrenal insufficiency.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule, or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends acceptance of this item on first reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
