
Administration of Medication for Adrenal Insufficiency, Rule 0520-01-13

The Background:

On March 23, 2017, Governor Haslam signed Public Chapter 84 that requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules allowing for the administration of medication that treats adrenal insufficiency for students while at school. This final read item sets forth rules for LEAs to follow in the administration of medication that treats adrenal insufficiency.

Since first reading, the rule was updated to:

- **Page 1** – Clarify which personnel LEAs must train to administer medication for the treatment of adrenal crisis.
- **Page 1** – Clarify that LEAs must provide training for the administration of medication for the treatment of adrenal crisis to eligible school personnel who volunteer.
- **Page 1** – Update the requirements for training supervision to align with the statute.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule, or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends adoption of this item on final reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
