On Thursday, January 30th every reporting agency in Tennessee should have received an e-mail from service@beyond2020. If you did not receive the email, please check your spam/junk folder. If it's not there, contact service@beyond2020.

The email should include up to five attachments: Your agency's NIBRS Agency Crime Overview, Crime in TN Review and your QC report from 2019. Please verify that your data matches the reports. Once you've verified your data, sign the Crime in TN Review at the bottom and e-mail it to Zack.Frisbee@tn.gov.

You should be able to run all three reports yourself, in CrimeInsight. On page 2-4 of this newsletter, I've provided instructions on how to run these reports. You can run these reports anytime. If you need assistance running these reports please contact your auditor or Zack Frisbee.
