We will send data for the time period of January—June 2018 in mid to late July. It is very important that you review any issues that are identified on the sheet accompanying your Crime in Tennessee page. Please pay close attention to any Hate Bias offenses identified with an “unknown” bias. We will also pass along questions from the FBI pertaining to trend changes, data quality, or reasonableness. You are the data owner and responsible for your data submission, updates and edits to correct any and all errors. We only publish what your agency submits; therefore, it’s critical that your data is accurate.

QC Exceptions

We recently made a change regarding duties in the TIBRS unit. Ashley Anderson will no longer be handling Quality Assurance (QC) issues. That responsibility has been transferred to the auditors. If you have a QC question, please contact your auditor for assistance. Ashley will still handle the errors, as she has in the past. If you have any questions, please give us a call or send an email!

TIBRS Reporting Tip

Question: A detective from your agency is running a sting operation for Human Trafficking. The detective is emailing back and forth with a potential perpetrator. The detective describes herself as a white female, aged thirteen. They agree to meet for sex. Law enforcement arrests the perpetrator. How do you enter the victim? The answer to this question is:

Victim Type: Individual (Law Enforcement cannot be a victim in scenarios like this)

Race: White

Sex: Female

Age: 13

In other words, the victim data is going to be whatever description the law enforcement officer uses during the sting operation. Categories that are not included in the description should be entered as Unknown. In this particular scenario, Resident Status, Ethnicity, etc. would all be entered as Unknown.

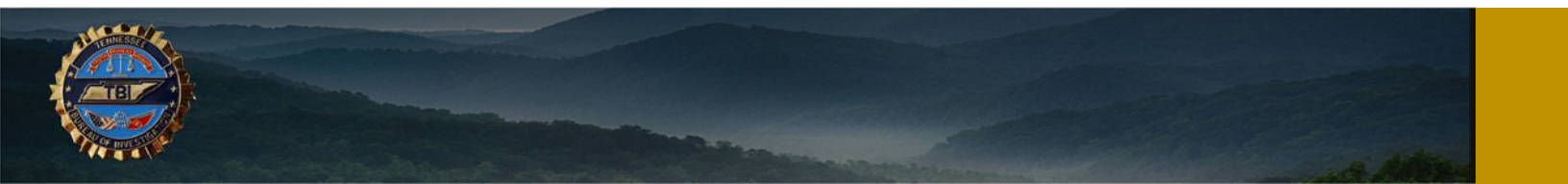
Group A and Group B – Same incident

When a Group A offense and a Group B offense occur in the same incident, only the Group A offense is reportable. For instance, if a person is found to be in possession of Meth, drug paraphernalia, and evades arrest, you would report the Drug/Narcotic Offenses and Drug Equipment Violation, Group A Offenses, to TIBRS, **NOT** the All Other Offenses (Evading Arrest), a Group B Offense.

But there is an exception to this rule when Driving Under the Influence is involved:

If a person is found to be Driving Under the Influence (DUI) and in possession of an illegal drug (Drug/Narcotic Violation), the agency has the **option** of reporting both the Group A offense and the Group B offense. The Drug/Narcotic Violation is a Group A offense and must be reported. It is the Group B that is optional. The incidents cannot be submitted together. If choosing to report both offenses, you must create/assign a different incident number when you submit the second incident of DUI, i.e., Drug/Narcotic Violation, Incident #346A; DUI, incident #346B.

If a person is found to be DUI and commits Negligent Vehicular Manslaughter, the agency has the **option** of reporting both the Group A offense and the Group B offense. The Negligent Vehicular Manslaughter is a Group A offense and must be reported. It is the Group B, DUI, which is optional. Once again, the incidents cannot be submitted together. If choosing to report both offenses, you must create/assign a different incident number when you submit the second incident of DUI, i.e., Negligent Vehicular Manslaughter, Incident #347A; DUI, incident #347B.





THOR Reminder (*TnCOP users only*):

Next month, THOR will be live. THOR is the State’s new CRMS/TnCOP site. It will function similar to the way TnCOP does now. The only big difference is the appearance. Once the site is fully developed, we will transfer everyone’s TnCOP login to the THOR site. The scheduled deployment date is July 1, 2018. The announcement will be in the July newsletter. We will also send a Listserv message and a training guide.
