The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), an Equal Opportunity/Affirmative Action Employer, seeks to retain the services of professional engineering consulting firms to provide on-call geotechnical engineering services as described below. The scope of work will include but not be limited to:

- a. geotechnical studies and engineering related primarily to geotechnical site exploration reports for roadways, interchanges, bridges, and earth retaining structures
- b. geotechnical subsurface exploration / drilling
- c. soils and materials laboratory testing
- d. development of CAD construction drawings

Method of payment for the Contract will be cost plus net fee for the engineering manpower services and negotiated unit rate basis for drilling and laboratory services. The initial maximum contract amount will be set at \$1,000,000. The contract may be amended to increase the contract ceiling, but in no event shall the maximum contract amount exceed \$5,000,000. The agreement shall be effective as of the contract execution date, and shall terminate March 31, 2021, except to the extent necessary to allow completion for previously issued work orders. Furthermore, no new work orders shall be issued after September 31, 2020.

All letters of interest must be received by the Materials and Tests Division on or before **4:00 p.m.** (Central Time) Wednesday, January 13, 2016. Please refer to the "Item number" in each letter of interest, as each item number represents a separate contract. Each item number will be evaluated separately. For those wishing to express interest in more than one contract, a separate letter of interest must be submitted for each item number. One package containing all the letters of interest is preferred.

Each letter of interest must indicate the scope of services anticipated to be completed by any subconsultant(s). The letter of interest shall not specifically identify sub-consultant(s), but rather indicate the scope of services anticipated to be completed by any sub-consultant(s). The subconsultant shall be prequalified by TDOT to perform the specific tasks required; a pending prequalification status will be acceptable. If a new pre-qualification form is being submitted, it must arrive at TDOT before the deadline above. (See Prequalification Procedures at http://www.tn.gov/tdot/article/consultantinfo-forms). The Department will evaluate the **current prequalification statements** on file for those submitting letters of interest, and choose several firms who would make viable candidates from which to invite proposals and/or presentations. The factors that will be considered in evaluation of proposals are:

- Ability and relevant expertise of the firm's personnel to be used in performing the service.
- b. Past experience in the required disciplines with TDOT and/or other clients.
- c. Qualifications and availability of professional staff.
- d. Qualifications and availability of drill crew staff that will be responsible for performing subsurface geotechnical testing and sampling.
- e. Soils and materials laboratory staff and testing accreditations.
- f. Qualifications and availability of CAD professional.
- g. Demonstrated ability to meet schedules, without compromising sound engineering practice.
- h. Evaluations on prior TDOT projects, if available.
- i. Size of project and limited or unlimited prequalification status.
- i. Amount of work currently under contract with TDOT.
- k. Whether the consultant can perform the work efficiently without compromising sound professional practices.

I. Other factors, including interviews and demonstrations, as approved by the Assistant Chief Engineer of Operations.

Evaluation proceedings will be conducted within the established guidelines regarding equal employment opportunity and nondiscriminatory action based upon the grounds of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, creed, age, and disability.
