


# **State Route 115 (US 129/Alcoa Highway)**

From Woodson Drive to Cherokee Trail Interchange Knox County

## **Project Information**

The 1.3 mile segment of State Route 115, from Woodson Drive to Cherokee Trail interchange, is one of seven sections of the overall proposed improvements along the State Route 115 corridor. The proposed project is intended to improve roadway safety and overall traffic operations. Currently the project is in the preliminary design phase.


The map below denotes the current project location.



### **Project Description**

The proposed improvements will follow the existing roadway and consist of widening State Route 115 to six 12 foot lanes (three lanes in each direction) with 12 foot shoulders. A center median barrier wall will be constructed throughout the project limits, thus eliminating left turns from State Route 115. The cross section below illustrates the proposed improvements.

### **Proposed State Route 115 Cross Section**



In addition to the proposed widening of State Route 115, improvements will also be made to the Woodson Drive intersection and the Cherokee Trail interchange. At the Woodson Drive intersection, a roundabout will be proposed to provide access from and onto the highway's exit and entrance ramps. At the Cherokee Trail interchange, improvements are being made to provide improved access to Cherokee Trail, UT Medical Center and the new Cherokee Farm Development.
