PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project consists of RESURFACING, SIDEWALK, STORM SEWER, SIGNAL, ELECTRIC/LIGHTING, LANDSCAPE, WATER LINE AND SANITARY SEWER RELOCATION. This project is located at SR-9 (N. Main St.) from Cullom Street to E. Broad Street; E. Broad Street from SR-9 to Lakefront Park Trailhead; Market Street from SR-9 to Cullom Street. Project Length is 0.553 Miles.

The water and sanitary sewer relocation will be funded by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant.
