Progress Update

- Base stone for roadway widening is being placed near W. Hamilton.
- Temporary power poles have been placed around the Whites Creek bridge for bridge widening work.
- Permanent poles are being placed on both Clarksville Pike and Ashland City Highway.
- AT&T conduit installation is underway near Briley Parkway.
- Comcast line relocation is underway.
- Retaining walls have been placed on the south end of Clarksville Pike.
- Greenway has been closed at the Whites Creek bridge for the bridge widening work.

Anticipated Schedule

- Work will continue on the new West Hamilton alignment.
- Moment slabs and parapet walls will be placed on top of the retaining walls.
- Power relocation will continue, including installation of temporary poles and relocating all utility power lines to these poles.
- Closure of Cedar Circle for new road alignment.
- Storm drain installation, and water and sewer line relocation will continue throughout the job.
