Notice of Change in 1915(c) HCBS Waivers - Posted August 1, 2024

The Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Finance & Administration is providing official notice of intent to renew the Section 1915(c) Home and Community Based Services Self-Determination (SD) Waiver, Comprehensive Aggregate Cap (CAC) Waiver, and Statewide (SW) Waiver:

Tennessee Self-Determination Waiver Program

These waivers are operated by the Department of Disability and Aging (DDA) under an Interagency Agreement with TennCare, the State Medicaid Agency.

The requested effective date of these changes is January 1, 2025.

The primary purpose of these waiver submissions is to submit the SW, CAC, and SD Waiver Applications for a renewal period of five years and to **resubmit** the changes **not** related to 1915(c) integration into managed care that were submitted to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) in September/November 2022.

The comment period begins August 1, 2024 and ends at close of business (4:30 p.m. Central) on September 2, 2024.
