OVERVIEW

THEC staff will provide an update on fall 2022 enrollment across Tennessee public institutions.

Each fall, THEC collects aggregate 14th day enrollment figures from the community colleges and universities. For fall 2022, undergraduate headcount is up 0.3 percent from fall 2021 and full-time equivalent undergraduate enrollment is up 0.8 percent across all institutions. Community college headcount is down 3.4 percent, while university undergraduate headcount is up 2.7 percent over census enrollment from fall 2021. Graduate student enrollment is down across most universities. More information can be found in Attachment I.

THEC staff will present newly available information on fall 2021, provide an update of fall 2022 enrollment changes, and situate TN enrollment within the national enrollment landscape. THEC staff will continue to evaluate student level data into early spring when unit record data is available.
