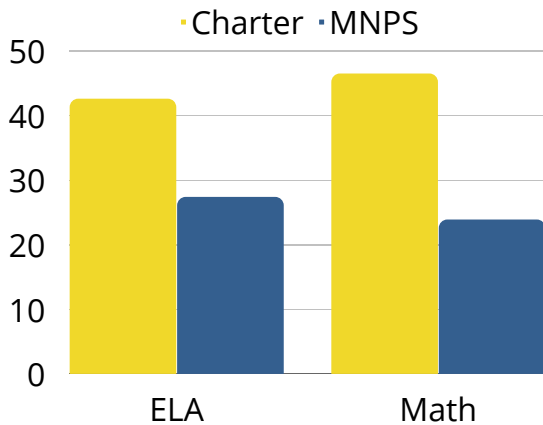

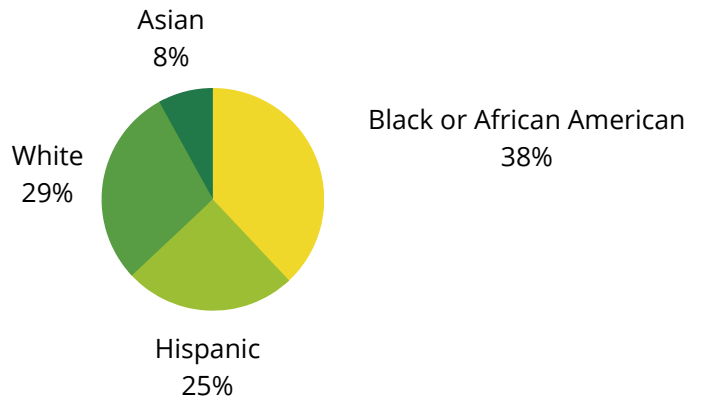
### PROFICIENCY

A Message from KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary:

KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary School is a high performing Charter school in the Antioch Community currently serving Kindergarten – 4<sup>th</sup> grade. We have proven to be one of the highest performing schools in Antioch, TN, recognized as being in the top 25% in the state of Tennessee.

As our school has grown over the past 4 years, we have thrived in serving our diverse student population with a model focused on Social and Emotional development. This is evident in our SEL practices taught in character classes and in the intentional student support structures, including 2 school counselors, Dean of Students and a Behavior Support Specialist.

We prioritize foundational literacy, devoting over 100 minutes to literacy in K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade. All staff are engaging in Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling Professional Development, rooted in Literacy best practices. With these intentional investments, over 75% of students at KACPE have reached on grade level reading proficiency and over 40% of our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders have achieved proficiency on state testing in ELA, math and science.

Our staffing model prioritizes teacher growth and student supports with Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade classes at a 15:1 ratio and students receiving targeted instruction from departmentalized teachers focused on becoming content experts. The creation of mid-level leader roles in SY 22-23, gives teachers a clear trajectory into school leadership while also increasing the support for both students and teacher development.

We are excited to share our successes in our annual report, and we look forward to seeing the KIPP Antioch mission and vision come alive as we continue to prepare our students with the skills and confidence to pursue the paths they choose.
