## TENNESSEE LITERACY SUCCESS ACT

- Requires districts and charter schools to create foundational literacy skills instruction plans by June 1, 2021.
- Requires K-5 students to participate in universal reading screening to identify students with reading deficiencies, at no cost to districts or schools.
- Parents will be notified in writing if child is found deficient in literacy skills.
- Districts and charter schools will have flexibility in developing these instruction plans.



# TENNESSEE LEARNING LOSS REMEDIATION AND STUDENT SUCCESS ACCELERATION ACT

- Establishes learning loss remediation programs outside of regular school hours to address COVID-19 retention slide.
- Requires interventions for priority students with afterschool learning mini-camps, learning loss bridge camps, and summer learning camps.
- Creates the Tennessee Accelerated Literacy and Learning Corps to provide ongoing tutoring for students throughout school year.
- Charter schools <u>may</u> participate, or districts can take in charter students through their programs.
- Districts may partner with community organizations to deliver these programs.

#### **ACCOUNTABILITY AND ASSESSMENTS**

- Maintains that all districts must administer in-person TCAP tests.
- Districts will need to test 80% of students to meet hold-harmless requirements.
- Districts with academic improvement may use these assessments, but negative impacts will not be considered for districts.
- Continues reporting of student outcomes.



# **TEACHER PAY**

- Commitment of adding \$42.8 million to the BEP salary component.
- The General Assembly made their intentions known that this funding should go <u>only</u> to pay raises for teachers.
- Charter school educators are included in the appropriation for teacher raises.
- These funds would provide an immediate pay increase for teachers and would be retroactive to January 1, 2021.



## 2021 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

- Sunset Hearings in the House and Senate Government Operations Committees.
- Appointment and confirmation of the 9<sup>th</sup> Commissioner.
- State of the State Address on February 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Education and Outreach to Stakeholders.
