ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

- The academic performance framework is made up of two key areas, student achievement (60%) and comparative performance (40%).
- The 2021-22 academic performance is based on the Commission's previous framework with and included some adaptations:
 - 1. In the absence of letter grades, academic performance is based on year 1 thresholds.
 - 2. Comparative performance was based on whether the school fell within 5% of the resident district.
 - 3. School culture was removed from this year's framework and will be reflected in the organizational section moving forward.



ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Bluff City High School - Falls Far Below

- Falls far below in areas of absolute performance in ELA (13%) and math.
- TVAAS 1
- 62% chronically absent
- Does not meet standards for comparative performance
- KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary and Middle Meets Standard
 Both schools meet standard for absolute performance and exceed

 - standard for comparative performance English Language Proficiency Assessments will be an area of focus for KIPP Middle as they do not meet standards on this metric
 - TVAAS 5 for middle school
 - 7.3% and 10.3% chronically absent at elementary and middle, respectively

- Nashville Collegiate Prep Does Not Meet
 Does not Meet Standard for absolute performance in ELA (25.5%) and math (20.7%)
- TVAAS 3
- 26% chronically absent
- Met standards for comparative performance, although performance fell below MNPS, but within 5%



FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

- The financial performance framework is comprised of ratings based on the schools near term and sustainability indicators.
- Near term indicators depict the school's financial position and viability in the coming year
- Sustainability measures indicate the school's longer-term financial position and viability over time



FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Bluff City High School - Does Not Meet

- Does not meet standard for cash flow and days cash on hand as a result of cash declining to 44 days cash on hand
- Enrollment variance falls far below at 79.5%
- Charter in default on two loan agreements as a result of being placed on academic probationary status

KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary and Middle - Meets Standard

- Audit reflects healthy financial position
- Decline in cash balances primarily due to expenses related to the construction of the new high school
- Nashville Collegiate Prep TBD
 - Audit has not yet been received from school and therefore financial performance has not been evaluated



ORGANIZATIONAL PERFORMANCE

- The organizational performance portion of the annual reports measures each school's overall organizational performance in the 2021-22 school year and includes:
 - Students with Disabilities and English Language Learner Rights
 - Governance and Reporting requirements
 - Student and Employee rights, including licensure
 - School Environment



ORGANIZATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Bluff City High School Meets Standard
 - Opportunities for growth remain in submitting reports timely and student attendance
- KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary and Middle Meets Standard
 - Both schools continue to not meet standards for teacher licensure
- Nashville Collegiate Prep Meets Standard
 - School demonstrated continuous improvement and came into compliance by the end of the year in areas including teacher licensure, reporting calendar, attendance, and teacher assignments
 - Met Standard however Commission staff continues to work closely with school on special populations monitoring
