SUBJECT: Executive Director Updates

## Commission Staffing

- With both growth of our portfolio of schools and the addition of three positions for FY24, the focus over the last few months has been a restructure of the district focused positions and the hiring of additional staff to add capacity.
- I spoke with several statewide authorizers that also serve as the LEA to determine how they set up and structure their overall teams. Most larger authorizers have a team focused on authorizing, a team focused on finance/operations, and a team focused on school supports.
- Given this feedback as well as where the greatest capacity needs of the staff are, I created a school programs and supports team that is separate and distinct from the finance and operations team.
- The school programs and supports team will work directly with schools on academic and support programs such as special education, English Learners, federal programs, summer learning, extended learning, and school safety.
- The finance and operations team will work with schools on budgets, federal grants, reimbursements, student information systems, assessments, and general compliance.
- The authorizing team will work on application review, overall performance management, site visits, district/school accountability, and pre-opening.
