





Charter Applications









Amendment Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A) § 49-13-110(d) and Charter Commission Rule 1185-01-01-.04, if a charter school desires to materially modify any of the provisions of its charter agreement, it must seek an amendment.

5 Year Review-Pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-13-121(d), the Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE) shall develop guidelines for local education agency (LEA) authorizers and charter schools to facilitate the fiveyear interim review process Renewal Applications T.C.A. § 49-13-121(k) sets
forth the procedures by
which a charter school may
renew its charter agreement
with its authorizer. A charter
school must submit a
renewal application to its
authorizer no later than
April1 of the year prior to the
year in which its charter
agreement expires.

New Start Application-On or before 11:59 p.m. CT on February 1 of the year preceding the year in which the proposed public charter school plans to begin operation, the charter school sponsor seeking to establish a public charter school shall prepare and file an electronic copy of the state charter school application with the authorizer and the department.

Consistent Review/Rating Process for Charter Applications

Provide training for review team members to ensure expectations of the review and rating of the application



Conduct a capacity interview with sponsors to ask clarifying questions when applicable.

Conduct a consensus meeting with review members to determine a consensus rating for each applicable section of the application.

Present Evidence Findings to the MNPS Board of Education

Board of Education votes to approve or deny the application.
