

Legal Services for Low-Income Veterans

The Tennessee Department of Veterans Services cannot provide legal representation for claims outside of appeals for which have jurisdiction and power of attorney. Additionally, the department cannot in good faith or as a matter of professional responsibility endorse a particular law firm or attorney.

We understand that many times you will receive a request from a veteran to recommend a particular law firm or attorney. Many such instances may be for a Veteran who has limited income. This fact sheet provides various “pro bono” legal aid groups who provide representation in various Tennessee courts of jurisdiction.
