### **Summary**

Over the month, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 3.1% from March's 3.2%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.1%.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased by 15,800 jobs. The largest increases were in Education & Health Services, Leisure & Hospitality, and Trade, Transportation, and Utilities.

Over the month, total nonfarm employment increased by 5,100 jobs. The largest increases were in Trade, Transportation, and Utilities, Education & Health Services, and Leisure and Hospitality.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2022 to 2024




# Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee
