THE STATE OF TENNESSEE MINE AND MINING LAWS AND REGULATIONS

TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED TITLE 59 MINES & MINING

59-1-115. ANNUAL LICENSE REQUIRED FOR MINE OPERATION.

(a) The owner or operator of each mine shall procure from the Department of Labor, Division of Mines, a license to operate a mine, and the license shall not be transferable. Any person who assumes control of a mine, opens a new mine, or reopens an abandoned mine shall procure a license to operate the mine before mining operations are begun. All licenses are valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance and shall be renewed annually.

59-1-117. FAILURE TO OBTAIN LICENSE.

Any owner or operator operating a mine and who fails to obtain a license as required by Section 59-1-115 and 59-1-116 shall forfeit the right to operate a mine in this state, and the commissioner of labor or his designated agent shall have the authority to close the mine until the license is obtained as provided for by those sections.
