

## Attention: Case Managers (CMs) and Case Manager Assistants (CMAs):

Important Dates to remember:

- Any "Case Manager Assistant" who registered with the Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation
  <u>before</u> January 1, 2017 is required to register as a "Case Manager", as defined by the Bureau's Case
  Management Rules, by December 31, 2018 in order to continue to provide case management services
  to employees in a workers' compensation claim.
- Any "Case Manager Assistant" who registered with the Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation
  <u>after</u> January 1, 2017 will be required to register as a "Case Manager", as defined by the Bureau's Case
  Management Rules, <u>before the second anniversary of their individual registration date</u> in order to
  continue to provide case management services to employees in a workers' compensation claim.
- Any "Case Manager" who has registered with the Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation must renew their registration with the Bureau <u>before the second anniversary of their individual registration</u> <u>date</u> in order to continue to provide case management services to employees in a workers' compensation claim.
