ZF Friedrichshafen AG, Commercial Vehicle Technology, has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent layoff effective February 3, 2022, with all separations complete by March 31, 2022. The total number of affected workers is 237. This company is located at 1103 Baddour Parkway Lebanon, TN 37087. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on December 3, 2021.

The employees at the facility are represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Northern Middle Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by Workforce Essentials, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Northern Middle Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
