GSK Consumer Health - Global Manufacturing & Supply has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent layoff which will have several stages to the layoff effective starting December 10, 2018 and completing on April 2, 2019. The total number of affected workers is 99. This company is located at 2149 Harbor Avenue, Memphis, TN 38113. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on October 11, 2018.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Local Workforce Development Area Greater Memphis rapid response team, employed by the Workforce Investment Network, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and effected

employees. The Local Workforce Development Board of Greater Memphis area will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
